



FAQ's for Returning to In-Person Worship

When and where will in-person worship take place?



In-person worship will take place weekly on Sunday morning from 9:45-10:15 a.m. Pre-registered persons will be admitted beginning at 9:30 a.m. through First Church's 516 Church Street entrance.

How do I "pre-register"?



Congregants/households must register online for in-person worship at least 24 hours in advance at www.faithatfirst.com/Save-A-Seat. All people, friends, visitors and members alike, are welcome to register. Registration will close 24 hours in advance of worship or once reservations meet the 50-person capacity.

What is the process for entering/exiting?



Congregants will enter through the 516 Church Street entrance. Upon arrival, persons will be required to sanitize their hands and have temperatures checked. At the end of the service congregants will be excused and directed out of the sanctuary and building to Hinman Ave. Service concludes at 10:15 a.m.

Will I (still) need to wear a mask?



Yes. All persons over the age of two are required to wear a mask or face covering, even if fully vaccinated.

What can I expect from the service? Will there be music?



You can expect scripture, praise, prayer, and a homily. Instrumental music will be played before and after the service. We will refrain from singing.
